Empowering Rural Women: Groundnut-Based Product Training Initiative by ICAR-CIPHET

The ICAR-Central Institute of Post-Harvest Engineering and Technology (CIPHET) conducted one day training programme on processing of groundnut for milk and paneer on February 13, 2023 for 38 women beneficiaries from five Self Help Groups (SHGs) across various villages in Jalandhar district, Punjab. This initiative, conducted under the SCSP (Scheduled Caste Sub Plan) Scheme of the Government of India, was a collaborative effort of the team from ICAR-CIPHET, Ludhiana and Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar.

The primary objective of the program was to enhance the income-generating capabilities of SC women by honing their skills in groundnut processing. Participants were equipped with knowledge spanning from the preparation of plant-based peanut milk to crafting flavoured beverages and paneer. Special emphasis was placed on extending the shelf life of milk through sterilization techniques.
