

ICAR-CIPHET, Ludhiana successfully completed 03 days Entrepreneurship Development program

January 25, 2024 ICAR–Central Institute of Post–Harvest Engineering and Technology, Ludhiana organized a three-days Entrepreneurship Development Program on “Valorization of fruits and by-products through primary and secondary processing” from 23rd to 25th January, 2024 under the CRP on SA project ‘Extraction of bioactive compounds and value addition to by-products of farms and agro-processing industries’. This training program was aimed to impart technical knowledge and hands-on-training to the participants for processing of fruits such as amla, guava and kinnow to obtain main products as well as converting the by-products into value added products through secondary processing. Five persons, including two women, from Fazilka and Shri Muktsar sahib district attended this EDP program.
